# Assistance Paying Your Water or Sewer Bill?



# Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP)



LIHWAP is a temporary emergency program that can help eligible households and families afford water and wastewater services, providing a one-time payment that is paid directly to the utility company. LIHWAP is available through September 2023 or until the funds are exhausted.

To be eligible, households must have an annual income at or below 60% of the State median income and have a demonstrated need for water assistance.

## LIHWAP can help with:

### FFY 2023 Low Income Guidelines

- Reconnection of water services
- Prevention of disconnection
- Past-due and current balances
